

# NOTICE June 22, 2019 Run-Off Election

## Hickiwan Community & Toha Biak Community For Hickiwan District Council

Pursuant to 12 T.O.C. Chapter 1, Article VIII, Section 1807 of the Nation's Elections law, a candidate must receive the highest number of votes cast for an office in order to be declared elected. Section 1807 further provides, that if the abstract shows the vote cast for two or more candidates for an office (with the highest vote) is tied, a run-off election shall be held not more than 30 days after the election. The May 25, 2019 General Election Official Abstract for the Hickiwan District reflects that there is a tie in the Hickiwan Community, for a Representative seat, between Ursula M. Enos and Amanda L. Reede-Estrella. The May 25, 2019 General Election Official Abstract for the Hickiwan District reflects that there is a tie in the Toha Biak Community, for an Alternate seat, between Millie Garcia and Mary E. Sam. Therefore, in accordance with Section 1807, a run-off election will be held in your district, for the individuals listed above on June 22, 2019.

To vote in the Hickiwan & Toha Biak Communities of the Hickiwan District for the June 22, 2019 run-off election you must have been registered to vote in the Hickiwan & Toha Biak Communities for the General Election held on May 25, 2019.
